Class Information

Maiden Yearling Halter Classes are open to all registered stock breeds: AQHA, APHA, ApHC, PHBA, & ABRA

Maiden Horse Definition

Horse cannot have shown as a weanling or yearling prior to this event. No futurity title holders or money earners are eligible in any breed.

Maiden Yearling Slot Halter Classes

- 1) Maiden- Open Yearling Stallion Futurity*
- 2) Maiden- Open Yearling Gelding Futurity*
- 3) Maiden- Open Yearling Mare Futurity*

**Halter Classes will run concurrently with respective AQHA Open Yearling Halter Class. AQHA Horses must enter the respective AQHA Class.*

Color Breed Bonus: Any horse holding Color Breed registration papers is eligible

Slot Rules

Slots are available for \$1,000.00 per year and must be renewed annually. Slots are sold on a first come, first served basis. The original slot purchaser will own the slot for its lifetime but may be leased for the current year with the approval of the futurity office. If the slot owner no longer wants to use the slot, the slot must be forfeited to the office. The slot owner cannot sell the slot to another party. A waiting list will be formed in the event all the slots are sold and any available slots will be made public and offered to the next party on the waiting list. Slots must be renewed on or before **March 15, 2018.**

Total Available Slots

- 25 Yearling Stallion Slots
- 25 Yearling Gelding Slots
- 25 Yearling Mare Slots

Deadlines:

All previous slot owners must be renewed on or before **March 15, 2018.** Any unsold Slots may be purchased after this deadline and before **April 5, 2018.** Slots sell immediately on a first come, first served basis.

Slot owners must name their entry (horse name & copy of papers) on or before **May 1, 2018** with an entry fee of \$500 due at that time plus a \$25 office fee. Late fees apply **May 15, 2018.**

Substitutions or Refunds

No Refunds. Substitutions will be allowed in the event of the death of the named horse with a vet certificate provided.
